What is the Message of Narcotics Anonymous?

“That an addict, any addict, can stop using drugs, lose the desire to use, and find a new way to live. Our message is hope and the promise of freedom.”

- Basic Text, pg. 68

What is the Narcotics Anonymous Program?

NA is a nonprofit fellowship or society of men and women for whom drugs had become a major problem. We are recovering addicts who meet regularly to help each other stay clean. This is a program of complete abstinence from all drugs. There is only one requirement for membership, the desire to stop using. We suggest that you keep an open mind and give yourself a break. Our program is a set of principles written so simply that we can follow them in our daily lives. The most important thing about them is that they work.

There are no strings attached to NA. We are not affiliated with any other organizations. We have no initiation fees or dues, no pledges to sign, no promises to make to anyone. We are not connected with any political, religious, or law enforcement groups, and are under no surveillance at any time. Anyone may join us regardless of age, race, sexual identity, creed, religion, or lack of religion.

We are not interested in what or how much you used or who your connections were, what you have done in the past, how much or how little you have, but only in what you want to do about your problem and how we can help. The newcomer is the most important person at any meeting, because we can only keep what we have by giving it away. We have learned from our group experience that those who keep coming to our meetings regularly stay clean.

¿Que es el programa de Narcóticos Anónimos?

NA es una confraternidad o asociación sin ánimo de lucro compuesta por hombres y mujeres para quienes las drogas se habían convertido en un problema muy grave. Somos adictos en recuperación y nos reunimos con regularidad para ayudarnos a permanecer “limpios”. Este es un programa de abstinencia completa de todo tipo de drogas. Sólo hay un requisito para ser miembro: el deseo de dejar de consumir. Sugerimos que mantengas una mente abierta para poder aprovechar esta oportunidad. Nuestro programa consiste en una serie de principios escritos de forma sencilla a fin de poder seguirlos diariamente. Lo más importante es que ¡funcionan!

En NA no te verás obligado a nada. No estamos afiliados a ninguna otra organización, no tenemos cuotas de inscripción ni se pagan honorarios, no obligamos a nadie a que firme ningún documento ni a que haga promesa alguna. No estamos asociados a ningún grupo político, religioso ni policial, y no estamos sometidos a la vigilancia de nadie. Cualquier persona puede unirse a nosotros sin que importe su edad, raza, identidad sexual, credo, religión ni la falta de esta última.

No nos interesa saber qué droga consumías ni qué cantidad, con quién te relacionabas, qué has hecho en el pasado, lo mucho o lo poco que tienes, sólo queremos saber qué quieres hacer con tu problema y cómo podemos ayudarte. El recién llegado es la persona más importante en nuestras reuniones, porque sólo podemos conservar lo que tenemos en la medida en que lo compartimos con otras personas. Nuestra experiencia colectiva nos ha enseñado que las personas que asisten a nuestras reuniones con regularidad se mantienen limpias.
